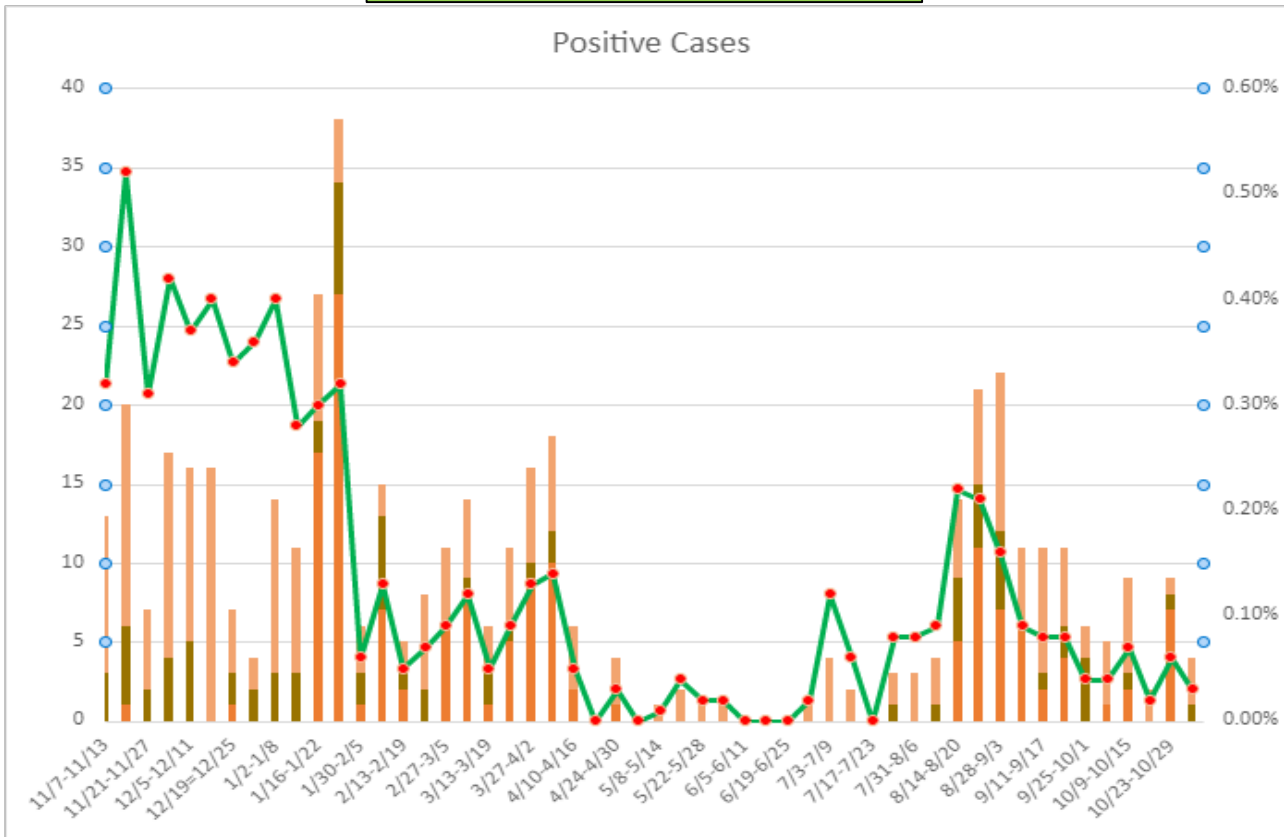

# Positive Cases Last Week

Current Status:

**Low Risk**



- ❖ Total positive tests: 4
  - Undergraduates: 0
  - Graduate students: 1
  - Faculty, staff, others: 3
- ❖ Total tests: 13,324
- ❖ Positivity rate: 0.03%

# Relaxation of Public Health Measures

---

- ❖ Masks for performances and technical rehearsals
- ❖ International travel
- ❖ Student-sponsored events and conferences
- ❖ Undergraduate participation in off-campus service and academic activities with children under 12 and individuals with unknown vaccination status
- ❖ In-person human subjects research
- ❖ Children under 12 as spectators at performances, athletic competitions, religious services
- ❖ Spouses and partners of graduate students access to testing, Dillon Gym, libraries

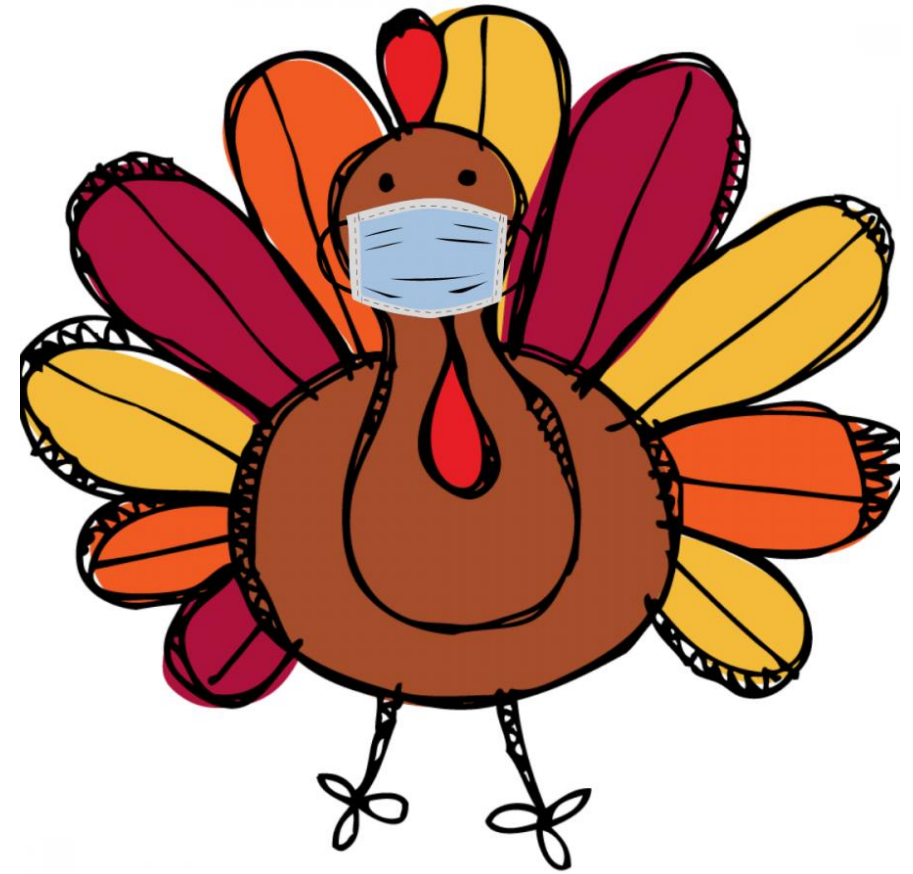
# New Mask Guidance

# Vaccines

- ❖ Pfizer available for children 5 to 11 years-old
- ❖ University clinics for any doses of Pfizer and Moderna
- ❖ Wednesdays - Pfizer
  - Expanded hours
  - Ages 5 and up
  - Boosters and third doses
- ❖ Thursdays – Moderna
  - Booster and third doses
- ❖ J&J – no campus clinics
  - Moderna or Pfizer; external clinics
